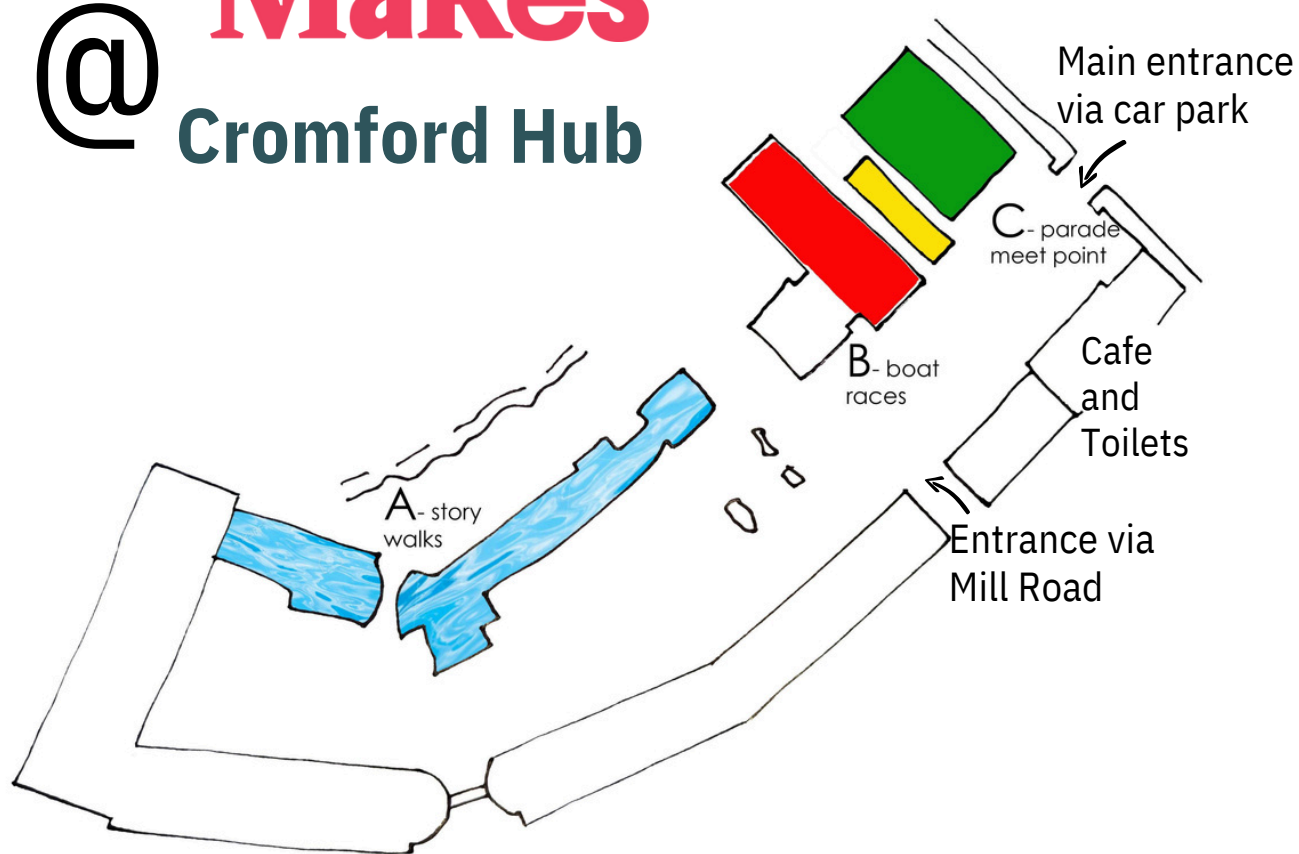


Derbyshire Makes @ Cromford Hub
